# Isaiah 64:1-9 Responsive

- <sup>1</sup>Oh, that you would rend the heavens and come down, that the mountains would tremble before you!
- <sup>2</sup>As when fire sets twigs ablaze and causes water to boil, come down to make your name known to your enemies and cause the nations to quake before you!
- <sup>3</sup> For when you did awesome things that we did not expect, you came down, and the mountains trembled before you.
- <sup>4</sup> Since ancient times no one has heard, no ear has perceived, no eye has seen any God besides you, who acts on behalf of those who wait for him.
- You come to the help of those who gladly do right, who remember your ways.
  But when we continued to sin against them, you were angry.
  How then can we be saved?
- <sup>6</sup> All of us have become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous acts are like filthy rags; we all shrivel up like a leaf, and like the wind our sins sweep us away.
- No one calls on your name or strives to lay hold of you; for you have hidden your face from us and have given us over to our sins.
- Yet you, LORD, are our Father.
  We are the clay, you are the potter;
  we are all the work of your hand.
- <sup>9</sup>Do not be angry beyond measure, LORD do not remember our sins forever.
- Oh, look on us, we pray, for we are all your people.

# 1 Corinthians 1:3-9 Responsive

- <sup>3</sup>Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- <sup>4</sup>I always thank my God for you because of his grace given you in Christ Jesus.
- <sup>5</sup>For in him you have been enriched in every way—with all kinds of speech and with all knowledge— <sup>6</sup>God thus confirming our testimony about Christ among you.
- <sup>7</sup>Therefore you do not lack any spiritual gift as you eagerly wait for our Lord Jesus Christ to be revealed.
- <sup>8</sup>He will also keep you firm to the end, so that you will be blameless on the day of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- God is faithful, who has called you into fellowship with his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

#### Mark 13:1-13 Responsive

- <sup>1</sup>As Jesus was leaving the temple, one of his disciples said to him, "Look, Teacher! What massive stones! What magnificent buildings!"
- <sup>2</sup>"Do you see all these great buildings?" replied Jesus. "Not one stone here will be left on another; every one will be thrown down."
- <sup>3</sup> As Jesus was sitting on the Mount of Olives opposite the temple, Peter, James, John and Andrew asked him privately, <sup>4</sup> "Tell us, when will these things happen? And what will be the sign that they are all about to be fulfilled?"
- <sup>5</sup>Jesus said to them: "Watch out that no one deceives you. <sup>6</sup>Many will come in my name, claiming, 'I am he,' and will deceive many. <sup>7</sup>When you hear of wars and rumors of wars, do not be alarmed. Such

things must happen, but the end is still to come.

Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. There will be earthquakes in various places, and famines. These are the beginning of birth pains.

<sup>9</sup>"You must be on your guard. You will be handed over to the local councils and flogged in the synagogues. On account of me you will stand before governors and kings as witnesses to them.

<sup>10</sup> And the gospel must first be preached to all nations. <sup>11</sup> Whenever you are arrested and brought to trial, do not worry beforehand about what to say. Just say whatever is given you at the time, for it is not you speaking, but the Holy Spirit.

"2"Brother will betray brother to death, and a father his child. Children will rebel against their parents and have them put to death. Everyone will hate you because of me, but the one who stands firm to the end will be saved.
